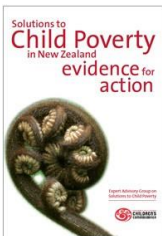

Dr Jonathan Boston is Professor of Public Policy and Director of the Institute for Governance and Public Policy within the School of Government at Victoria University of Wellington. During 2012 he was the co-chair (with Dr Tracey McIntosh) of the Expert Advisory Group on Solutions to Child Poverty established by the Commissioner for Children, Dr Russell Wills.
